

# Small and Large Businesses: Get Help to Come Back Stronger

Receive up to \$50,000 in grant assistance and help rebuild your business with the COVID-19 Economic Relief Program from RG&E.

Funding assistance could be available for your business if it incurred costs related to COVID-19 after March 15, 2020. To receive an award, you must complete an application and document the COVID-19-related costs. Awarded funding will initially be applied to any customer overdue balances, to ensure customer accounts are current.

Examples of costs incurred could be, but are not limited to:

- Cybersecurity improvements
- Consulting services
- Workforce training and development
- Retention and recruitment costs
- Electric and/or heating inspections by contractors
- Enhanced energy efficiency assistance
- Engineering redesign services
- Cleaning services
- Employee educational services
- Additional electric infrastructure projects

To help determine your likelihood of eligibility as a Rochester Gas and Electric (RG&E) service customer, find the “Electricity Service” row in the “DETAILED ACCOUNT ACTIVITY” section on page 3 of your RG&E electricity bill and look for one of the “SC” classifications outlined in the table that follows below.

 **Electricity Service – PSC19 SC8 Primary Time-of-Use  
Electricity Rate – ESCO Hourly Pricing**

If the code shown in the “Electricity Service” field of your bill matches one of the rates in the table below, your company is likely eligible for grant assistance. Further, for some of the rate categories, companies that have high enough monthly peak demands can qualify as a large business for a higher award:

RG&E Business Customer Classification	Eligible Electricity Rate Classes and kW Levels	Funding Available
Large Business	SC 8 (with $\geq$ 300 kW peak monthly demand within the last 24 months), SC 14 Standby STI SC8, SC 14 Standby SubTC, SC 14 Standby Subst SC8, SC 14 Standby Primary SC8, SC 14 Standby Sec SC8	Up to \$50,000
Small Business	SC 3, SC 7, SC 9, SC 14 Standby SC3	Up to \$15,000
